- Rehearse sufficiently for optimum performance
- Arrange for a substitute when not able to be present
- Accompany the choir's singing of music during special times of worship such as Tenebrae, Christmas Eve Candlelight, and provide extra practices if necessary
- Encourage church member participation in our music program by recruiting and organizing volunteers, which may include instrumentalists, vocalists, and choir members
- Participate in community outreach via performances at other organizations as appropriate

- Prepare appropriate music and be available when asked for special events, which may include weddings, funerals (extra fee paid)
- Ensure proper maintenance of musical instruments, manage relationships with service providers like piano tuners and technicians, and keep all relevant spaces orderly and tidy
- Collaborate with the Worship and Music Committee to continue the growth in our music programs
- Manage expenses to the approved budget
- Monitor copyright restrictions and ensure appropriate licensing is maintained
